

2. All users of MbPT Railways

Dear Sir,

Sub: Allocation of platform sheds 'T' & 'H' at Grain Depot for unloading/storage of rail-borne cargoes on temporary basis.

On the request received from trade for additional storage areas, it has been decided to earmark T' Shed, having 9000 sq.mtr. usable area, out of which 8741 sq.mtr. is vacant, and H' Shed, having 4650 sq.mtr. usable area which is fully vacant, for unloading/storage of rail-borne cargoes for temporary period in Mumbai Port Trust on common users' basis as per the laid down terms and conditions of Mumbai Port Trust such as:

- a) The permission for storage of goods inside these sheds is given by the Railway Manager and the charges recovered are on 'Casual Occupancy basis' as provided under General Bye Law No.9 as per T.R. 10 of 1992.
- b) Under Casual Occupancy, Rs.1.50 per sq. mtrs. per day for the first 15 days and Rs.2.00 per sq. mtrs. per day from 16th day till removal of the cargo is leviable.
- c) Mumbai Port Trust shall not be responsible for any loss, damage or theft of cargo.
- d) Removal of cargo to be done under written intimation to the Station Master, Grain Depot.
- e) Upon its requirement by MbPT, the subject sheds to be vacated in 15 days'.

The modalities for the use of above sheds and the conditions applicable shall be as already stipulated and in vogue for usage of platform sheds 'A', 'B', 'C' & 'D', 'F' & 'G'.

You are therefore, requested to give vide publicity amongst your members/Port Users to take advantage of the facilities offered by the MbPT Railway and bring more and more rail-borne cargo through MbPT Railway to the Port.



These General Bye-Laws are applicable to areas excluding premises to which the provisions BPT Docks or Bunders Scale of Rates or the BPT Railway Goods Tariff are applicable. areas under the Bunder and Railway management have already been transferred to the unsdiction of the Estate Department vide TR No.26 of 1990.

- To attract more traffic a few more sidings are being converted with block rake facility. The advantage for handling train load facility would be nullified unless the consignors/consignees are required to do loading/unloading of wagons. It is therefore proposed that para 75 of BPT Railway Goods Tariff No.5 should be amended as detailed in @Annexure 'A'. These amendments are generally consistent with relevant rule No.128 of Indian Railways Conference Association Goods Tariff in force. Board's sanction is requested to these amendments subject to sanction of the Central Government (Ministry of Railways) under section 87 of Indian Railways Act, 1989.
 - 3. Normally when unloading of wagon is done by the consignee, he signs the delivery memo after unloading. A situation may arise that even after taking delivery of the goods, he may require some transit storage either in shed or in the open areas till a transitive space is available in the dock sheds, especially in case of export cargo.
