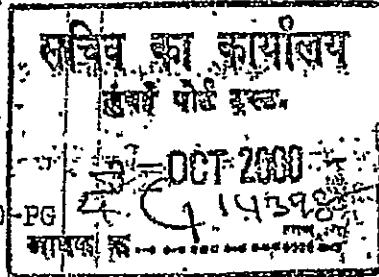

It has come to the notice of this Department that Major Port Trusts incur enormous expenditure on distributing gifts/mementos to their employees and to dignitaries who visit the Ports.

The Boards of Trustees of the Major Port Trusts are not authorised to incur such expenditure, unless under clause (1) of Sub-section (1) of Section 88 of the MPT Act, 1963 prior approval of the Central Government is obtained.

In view of the above, the Port Trusts are advised to ensure that no expenditure is incurred on gifts/mementos as aforesaid. In exceptional circumstances, if any expenditure is required to be incurred on such items, prior approval of the Central Government should be obtained by the Board of Trustees. Failure to comply with these directions will be viewed seriously.
