
Sub: COVID-19 precautions  
- Wearing of face mask in Docks.

Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) has issued strict instructions for observance of COVID appropriate behavior in public places in the wake of the possible 3<sup>rd</sup> wave of COVID-19. Wearing of face mask has been made mandatory in all public places.

2. To enforce wearing of face masks by all employees and port users in the docks, it has been decided to depute MCGM marshals for implementation of the same. The MCGM Marshals shall recover applicable penalty from those defaulters, who are found not wearing face masks as per MCGM orders.

3. All are requested to extend their co-operation in this effort and direct your all employees to strictly observe COVID appropriate behavior and keep the Port free of COVID.

4. All the persons whether employee, Port Users, Govt. Agencies' Personnel, etc. are requested to note that those who are repeatedly found breaking the law, are liable to be denied entry into docks by suspension of Dock Entry Permit facilities.
