Sub: Storage facilities for import Gypsum/MOP and other such bulk cargo at Mumbai Port Trust.

Ref: This office Circular No. TM/D/4-3/05 dated 12.05.2017.

Vide this office circular referred above, Trade was informed about Board's approval for the storage of Gypsum/MOP and other such Bulk Cargo in the notified areas upto 150 days on License Fee basis for a period of one year from 28.04.2017, at the rates specified therein.

2. Board has accorded approval for the extension of the facility of storage of Gypsum / MOP and other such bulk cargo in the notified areas upto maximum period of 180 days for a period of one year from 16.03.2018, on recovery of charges as under:-

A) For Areas under SOR:

- 3. It should be noted that trade will have to pay revised Licence Fees as and when approved by the TAMP and /or when the Mumbai Port Trust (General Management of Port) Regulations comes into effect.
- 4. The scheme will remain valid for a period of one year from 16.03.2018 and reviewed thereafter.
- 5. These being bulk cargoes, the precautions for pollution control measures will have to be taken by consignees/their handling Agents, as would be intimated from time to time, during handling, transport, storage, etc.
- 6. You are requested to inform your members accordingly and bring more cargo to the Port.
