> Sub : Keeping Ferry Wharf Jetty No.3 vacant for creating RO-RO PAX facility

Mumbai Port Trust (MbPT) has undertaken work of providing infrastructure at Ferry Wharf Jetty no.3 (Erstwhile Mogal Jetty) to facilitate RO-RO PAX service which will connect Mumbai with Mandwa & Nerul. This is an important project which will alleviate transportation woes of commuters travelling from Mumbai to Navi Mumbai / Alibaug as they will be in a position to travel alongwith their personal vehicles and save lot of time and fuel by availing RO-RO PAX facility.

2. The work of the above referred project has commenced and berthing of crafts at the subject Ferry Wharf Jetty obstructs the work.

3. It is observed that despite repeated requests / notices by officials of Port and Traffic Department for not berthing of crafts at Ferry Wharf Jetty No.3, various barge owners / operators, etc. continue to unauthorisedly berth their crafts at Ferry Wharf Jetty no.3.

4. In view of above, you are requested to advise your members not to berth their crafts at the entire stretch of the subject jetty, failing which strict action will be initiated against the erring Vessel Agents / Barge Owners/ Tug Operators, etc. which may include black listing of company or cancellation of licenses of the craft issued by MbPT.
