In supersession to this office above referred Circular No.TM/D/4-3/6 dated 16.05.2017, this is to inform that on examination, TAMP has informed that the adjusted SOR after applying the applicable annual escalation factor of 2% announced by the Authority for the year 2017-18 subject to achievement of Performance Standards will come into force from 1st May 2017 instead of 1st April 2017, as per Clause 3.7 of the working guidelines issued to operationalize the Tariff Policy, 2015 issued by the Ministry of Shipping.

- 2. Accordingly, Section 2.17 pertaining to Composite Berth Hire Charges will stand revised and the new rates will be effective from 01.05.2017. The revised scale of rates can be perused on website "www.mumbaiport.gov.in".
- 3. It may please be noted that payment of advance deposit and billing towards all charges will have to be made as per the revised rates effective from 01.05.2017.
