**Sub : Grant of extended free days for levy of
demurrage on Import Raw Sugar.**

Ref : This office Circular No.TM/M/13-5/Circular/30
of 95-96 dated 03.12.2016.

By circular dated 03.12.2016 referred to above, the facility of extended free days for cargo/containers till 19.11.2017 was conveyed.

2. The Board has now accorded sanction to extend 6 calendar free days in addition to the 6 calendar free days already available under the above referred circular, following the date of vessel completing discharging operation, only for import raw sugar. Thus there shall be 12 calendar days free following the date of vessel completing discharge operation for raw sugar.

(Note : The free days are calendar days and in computing number of free days, Dock holidays, Sundays, Custom holidays shall be included.)

3. The 12 free days shall be allowed only for vessels berthed inside the Indira Dock berths on or before 30.06.2017.

4. The Port users are requested to take note of the above and bring more raw sugar to the port.
