**Minutes of the Dry Dock Allotment Planning Meeting  
held on 25-04-2017 at 11.00 a.m.**

The Dry Dock Allotment Planning meeting was held with the Users of Dry dock at 11.00 a.m. on 25-04-2017 in Nirman Bhavan. Representatives of around 31 user firms were present in the meeting which was convened by Shri V.V. Prabhu, Dy. Chief Mechanical Engineer.

2. At the outset, Dy. CME welcomed all the Dry Dock Users.
3. Dy. CME informed that allotments shall be tentatively made for the forthcoming quarter i.e. from May 2017 to July 2017. He further informed that applications dated upto 31-08-2013 (from sr. no. 1 to 11 of Dry Dock list as on 25-04-2017) will be deleted if they do not take allotment during the ensuing period upto July 2017.
4. A tentative Dry Docking programme for HDD has been drawn scheduled from 20-05-2017 upto 16-09-2017. The schedule of tentative programme of Dry Docking as discussed and agreed by the representatives present in the meeting is enclosed subject to MbPT reserving the right to make changes considering emergencies and further changes if any required to be done to conform to the priority rules applicable for the Navy, Coast Guard and MDL vessels as approved by the Board.
