Sub: Storage facilities for import pulses.

Vide this office circulars referred above, the facility of storage of import pulses in the notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days was extended for a period of one year from 01.08.2015.

2. The Board has accorded approval for the extension of the facility of storage of import pulses in the notified areas upto a maximum period of

180 days for a period of one year from 01.08.2016 on recovery of charges as under –

Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	40.00
	31st day to 180th day	80.00
Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	30.00

In the event of non-clearance of the consignments within the period of 180 days, demurrage shall be recovered from 181st day onwards at the rates specified in Section 3.1 (B) of Chapter III of the SOR.

3. However, in view of general revision of Scale of Rates effective from 19.08.2016, the charges would be as under –

Location	Period of Storage	Rate per Sq. Mtr. or part thereof, per month or part thereof (in Rs.)
Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	68.00
	31st day to 180th day	136.00
Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	51.00
	31st day to 180th day	102.00

In the event of non-clearance of the consignments within the period of 180 days, demurrage shall be recovered from 181st day onwards at the rates specified in Section 3.1 (B) of Chapter III of the revised SOR.

- 4. As regards implementation of the rates for the period covering both prerevised rate and revised rate, the charges would be made applicable on pro-rata basis for period covered.
- 5. For the areas covered under GBL, storage will be limited upto 180 days; whereafter charges @ Rs. 20/- per sq. mtr. per day will be leviable from 181st day onwards as conveyed vide circular No. TM/D/4-3/01 of 2012-13 dated 10.04.2012.
- 6. The above scheme will remain valid for a period of one year from 01.08.2016.
- 7. You are requested to inform your members accordingly.
