**Sub : Article 22 rectified convention No.127 concerning  
maximum weight ILO Convention 1967 – Reg.**

The Dy. Director (Safety), Inspectorate Dock Safety, Mumbai, has drawn attention towards the provisions under Recommendation No.128 made under ILO Convention No.127, which prescribes that the maximum permissible weight to be carried manually by one adult male worker should not exceed 55 kg. The Tripartite Committee on Conventions under the Ministry of Labour decided to fix 50 kg. as the maximum permissible weight.

2. You are requested to advise your members for compliance of the same.
