Sub : Pre Arrival Notification of Security (PANS)  
for vessels calling Mumbai Port.

.....

Subsequent to this office Circular Nos.DC/C-SH/2105 & 2439 dated 13.05.2013 & 06.06.2013 respectively regarding Pre Arrival Notification of Security (PANS) by merchant ships entering Indian Ports.

2. It is now required that advance arrival information (PANS) for Port of Mumbai is required 96 hours in advance of schedule time of arrival of a vessel as per ISPS plan.

3. If the voyage is of less than 96 hours, then this information shall be submitted within 2 hours of departure from the last port. This also applies to vessels trading in coastal water or coasting between Indian Ports.
