**Sub.: Concessional charges for storage of
Empty containers at designated
Yards/CFSs of Mumbai Port.**

Ref : TM/C/3-93/15 of 1988-89 dtd 16.09.2013.

Vide the above referred circular, the facility for storage of empty containers at concessional charges at designated areas and other CFS areas was extended upto 31.03.2014.

It has now been decided to extend the facility as under for storage of empty containers at concessional rates for a further period of one year from 01.04.2014 or till the date of revision of SOR, whichever is earlier.

i) Empty containers stored in nominated areas (viz. Golden Yard, Wadala) other than Container Freight Station whether Custom declared or otherwise. (charges to be recovered from the date of receiving till date of removal)	Rs.13.00	Rs.26.00	Rs.39.00
ii) Container de-stuffed and stored in Container Freight Stations. (concessional charges to be recovered from the 4th day from date of de-stuffing till date of removal or stuffing of container. For first three days charges will be as per Scale of Rates)	US Cents 65	US \$ 1.30	US \$ 1.95

These concessional rates shall not apply for containers handled in Docks proper.

2. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members regarding the aforesaid facility offered at concessional rates for storage of empty containers and handle more containers through Mumbai Port.
