Sub: Storage facilities for import pulses

Ref : This office circular No.TM/D/4-3/10 of 1996-97

dated 01.07.2013.

Vide this office Circular referred above, the Trade was informed about extension of maximum storage period from 180 to 270 days. The said scheme expired on 30.09.13. This is to inform that the Board has now accorded sanction to the extension of said scheme upto 31.03.2014. Accordingly, the maximum permissible period for storage of import pulses will be 270 days or 31.03.14, whichever is earlier as under:

(i) For the areas under SOR rate of Rs.40/- per sq.m. per month for the first month. Rs.80/- per sq.mtr. per month for the next 05 months and demurrage of Rs.5/- per tonne per day thereafter upto 270<sup>th</sup> day or 31.03.2014, whichever is earlier shall be levied. After 270<sup>th</sup> day or expiry of 31.03.2014, demurrage as per SOR shall be levied. The balance demurrage as applicable under SOR after 180<sup>th</sup> day is to be treated as remitted under Section 53 of Major Port Trusts Act, 1963.

- (ii) For the areas under GBL, if permission is granted for storage of cargo, the rates leviable are Rs.1.50/- per sq.m. per day for the first 15 days and Rs.2/- per sq.m. per day for the rest. If the storage continued beyond 180 days, charges at the rate of Rs.6/- per sq.m. per day for cargo upto 270 days or 31.03.2014, whichever is earlier shall be levied. In case of any cargo not removed beyond 270 days/on or before 31.03.2014, penal charges @Rs.20/- per sq.mtr. per day as provided in the GBL shall be levied.
