**Minutes of the Dry Dock Allotment Planning Meeting**  
**Convened by DY.CME held on 25.02.2013**

The Open Public Dry Dock Allotment Planning meeting was held at 3.00 p.m. on 25.02.2013. Representatives of 19 user firms were present at the meeting. Dy. CME presided over the meeting.

2. At the outset, Dy. CME welcomed all the Dry Dock users and reiterated that the allotment for the Dry dock is being done, as a practice, on 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis. As per the policy, preference is given to the vessels of MbPT, Navy, Coast Guard and other Government Agencies as also vessels which are being used for Port operations. He further informed that as discussed and minuted in the meeting held on 10.12.2012, the names of users/vessels applied during 2010 have been deleted from the list of Docking applications except those who confirmed the requirement.

3. Dy. CME told the members that this is the forum where the D.D. users can express their suggestions/views/comments and requested them to give their views/suggestions/ comments in writing to improve the system as brought out in the minutes of the last meeting held on 10.12.2012. Dy. CME stated that dry docking application list is valid for one year and an extension of 3 months can only be considered. This has already been discussed in the last meeting held on 10.12.2012 and the same has been minuted.

4. Dy. CME informed that for interchange of any vessel, the names of both the vessels should have been registered and such requests should reach in this office prior to the Dry docking meeting.

5. DY.CME informed that those who have arrears of payment will not be considered for Dry Dock allotment and users who are listed in the payment pending list will have to bring 'No dues certificate' before granting Dry Docking permission/allotment.

6. Dy. CME informed about the Dry Dock slot available in the first week of March 2013 and enquired whether anybody is in readiness for the period. There was no response and accordingly Outer compartment has been kept vacant from 05.03.2013 to 15.03.2013. Subsequently, M/s. OSM Ship Management Pte Ltd. vide their application dated 28.02.2013 requested Dry Dock slot on/around 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2013 for 10 days and since the Outer compartment has been kept vacant, the vessel was allotted in Outer compartment for 10 days from 05.3.2013.

7. The request of Indian Navy for INS Teg will be considered in the next meeting. Similarly, requests for Dry Dock slots in May/June 2013 will be considered in the next meeting. Request of M/s. TAG Offshore Ltd. for TAG Mamta for 4 days will be considered if any other vessel is having the requirement of Dry Dock for same period, by end of March 2013.

8. Statement showing the status of the pending applications for allotment of Dry dock was read out to all the firms' representatives who were present in the meeting. A copy of the statement was furnished to all representatives who were present. A tentative Dry docking programme for HDD has been drawn scheduled from 04.3.2013.

9. A Schedule of Tentative Programme of Dry Docking as discussed in the meeting is enclosed. MbPT reserves the right to make changes considering the deserving cases of emergency.

10. Next Dry Dock Allotment Meeting is scheduled in the 2<sup>nd</sup> week of April, 2013.
