Sub : Beaching of M.V. Khalijia 3at Mumbai Port.

The Hon'ble Judge of the Mumbai High Court (Admiralty) has directed that M.V. Khalijia-3 be beached at Mumbai Port. Beaching will be programmed on any day between 14th and 19th June subject to the weather conditions. The vessel is presently anchored at V-2 anchorage and would commence her passage at about 3 hours before the high water tide time on a particular day (daytime hours only)

M.V. Khalijia-3 is in a delicate and damaged condition and would have to be manoeuvred with utmost caution and care, given the present circumstances. Therefore, all vessels are required to give M.V. Khalijia-3 a wide berth and avoid coming within close proximity and wherever unavoidable proceed at absolutely minimum slow speed. The safe passage of Khalijia-3 is not to be impeded in any way. All vessels, especially those having Pass Pilot License are not to anchor or come in way of Khalijia-3 at any stage or time during her beaching passage. The Department of Fisheries is also hereby requested to ensure that all fishing vessels operating inside the harbour take heed and keep clear of the m.v Khalijia 3.

The exact date of the vessel's beaching will be promulgated by an ensuing circular and on VTS/VHF radio channel 12.

All concerned are hereby requested to kindly take note and ensure safe passage of M.V. Khalijia-3 from the designated anchorage berth V-2 to the beaching plot at Darukhana area, which is located north of Mazagon Dock.
