Sub: Concessional charges for storage of empty containers at designated yards of Mumbai Port.

Ref: TM/C/3-93/24 of 1988-89 dated 07.03.2007.

Vide the above referred circular, the facility for storage of empty containers at concessional charges at designated areas and other CFS areas was allowed upto 10.3.2008. It has now been decided to reintroduce the facility for storage of empty container at concessional charges for a period of one year with effect from 08.9.2008 as follows:

These concessional rates shall not apply for containers handled in Docks proper.

2. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members regarding the aforesaid facility offered at concessional rates for storage of empty containers and handle more containers through Mumbai Port.
