CONCESSIONAL RATES FOR DEMURRAGE ON EXPORT OF AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

Sub: Concessional rates for demurrage on

export of agricultural products.

Vide circular No.TM/D/4-3/3 of 96-97 dated 27.4.2007, concessional rates for demurrage on export of agricultural products were introduced from 27.4.2007 for one year. The scheme was discontinued after 26.4.2008 and trade was informed vide Circular No.TM/D/4-3/01 of 1996-97 dated 24.4.2008.

- 2. Pursuant to receipt of representations from the exporters of Agri-commodities and their Associations, the Board of Trustees after reviewing the scheme approved the following concessional rates for recovery of demurrage for export of agricultural products after expiry of free days as under:
 - i) Rs.10/- per ton per day from 1^{st} to 20^{th} day as against Rs.37.50.
 - ii) Rs.25/- per ton per day from 21^{st} to 40^{th} day as against Rs.56.25.
 - iii) Rs.60/- per ton per day from 41st day onwards as against Rs.75.00.
- 3. The above rates will be effective from 27th April 2008 <u>for one year.</u> Differential amount would be remitted.
- 4. All exporters of agricultural commodities and their Associations are requested to avail the concerned facilities and route their exports of agri-products through Mumbai Port.
- 5. Wide publicity to the above concessional rates be given to all concerned.
