Sub: Handling of fertilizers/fertilizer raw

materials at No.4 and No,5 Hay Bunder

Ref: Circular No.TM/B/1-13/9 of 2003-04 dated 19.5.2007

Kind attention is invited to the above mentioned circular informing therein that mother vessels carrying fertilizer/fertilizer raw materials shall be permitted to discharge their cargo in stream into barges for offloading the same at No.4 and No.5 Hay Bunder with 15 days free period for the cargo

from the date of discharge of the first barge of the mother vessel.

The procedure to be followed by the Vessel Agents is as under:

1. They should pay advance deposit at the OSC counter as is being done in respect of stevedoring charges. The only difference will be instead of Rs.112.90 per m.t. (without gear) on the manifested quantity, the charges will be Rs.135.48 per m.t. (without gear) for discharge in stream.
2. In case of cargo handled in excess of the manifested quantity, supplementary charges should be paid immediately.
3. They should furnish a copy of the PDR showing payment of charges on the manifested quantity/excess quantity to the Shed Superintendent, Hay Bunder before commencement of the discharging operations.
