**Sub. :- General Revision of Scale of Rates –  
Container related charges.**

dt.28/09/2006.**

The Tariff Authority for Major Ports vide its' order dated 28/09/2006 published in Part-III Section(IV) of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary on 01/12/2006 has approved the proposal from MbPT for general revision of the Scale of Rates.

Salient features of revised Scale of Rate at Chapter V for container related charges are as under :-

1. Charges on lashing and unlashng of container excluded from the Composite Boxrate and therefore no rebate admissible on this account to the vessel agent.
2. A separate Composite Boxrate for Hazardous container has been introduced, e.g. 20' loaded container Rs.3095/- for gantry crane operation and Rs.2345/- for non gantry operation.
3. For every reefer plug point allotted, a charge of US \$ 6.5 (coastal Rs.282.90) per container per unit of 4 hours or part thereof will be levied.
4. Composite Boxrates for shifting of Onboard containers have been introduced, e.g. 20' loaded container Rs.1222/- for gantry crane operation and Rs.580/- for non gantry operation..
5. Storage (Licence) fee at the rate of US \$ 7.5 per container per day or part thereof has been introduced for container having length above 40'.
6. Storage (Licence) fee for Hazardous container to be charged at 25% premium on Storage (Licence) fee applicable for General containers.
7. Wharfage on cargo inside the export loaded container received from other than

port premises excluding container received from ICD shall be charged Rs.1000 (Coastal Rs.600/-) for a container having length upto 20 feet, Rs.1500(Coastal Rs.900/-) for a container having length upto 40 feet and Rs.2000 (Coastal Rs.1200/-) for a container having length over 40 feet.

Accordingly the PDR formats for container related charges have been revised w.e.f. 31.12.2006. Revised PDR formats for lodgement of advance deposit for Gantry crane operations- Foreign voyage, Gantry crane operations – Coastal voyage, Non-gantry crane operation – Foreign voyage and Non-gantry crane operation – Coastal voyage are enclosed herewith for ready reference.

All concerned are hereby requested to pay the PDR in the revised format w.e.f. 31/12/2006.
