**NOTIFICATION**

G.S.R. .... In exercise of powers conferred by Section 6 of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (15 of 1908), the Central Government hereby amends the notification G.S.R. No. 600 (E) dated 20.09.2005 to regulate the entry of vessels into ports. Para 2 (ii) of the above notification is substituted with the following -

- (ii) Pollution damage caused by spillage of oil or any hazardous and noxious substances;  
From a Protection and Indemnity Club which is a member of an International Group of Protection and Indemnity Clubs; or any Indian Insurance Company or a Club or an Insurance Company approved by the Central Government"

The amendment comes into force with immediate effect.
