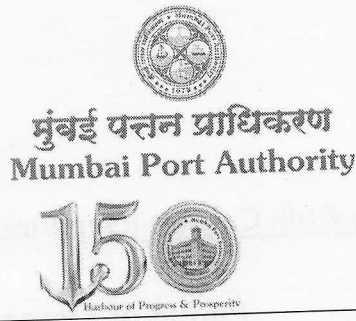

Sirs,

Sub : Storage facilities for import MOP and other such bulk cargo at Mumbai Port Authority for a period upto 180 days and upto 240 days for Gypsum.

Ref : This office circular No.TM/D/4-3/28 of 2022-23 dated 21.03.2024

By BR No.277 dated 06.03.2023, the Board had approved the storage of MOP and other such bulk cargoes upto a maximum period of 180 days and for Gypsum for 240 days in Sheds/ Warehouses at outlying areas, on storage basis for a period of one year with effect from 16.3.2023. as per the rates provided at Section 3.3(A)(II) and (V) of the Scale of Rates (SOR) as under:-


For Dry Bulk Cargo ; (Gypsum/MOP/Other such bulk cargo)

Location	Period of Storage	Rate per Sq. Mtr. or part thereof, per month or part thereof (in ₹.)
Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	93.00
	31 st day to 180 th day (upto 240 days for Gypsum)	189.00
Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	71.00
	31 st day to 180 th day	144.00
Sheds/ Open Yards	181 st day onwards (241 st day onwards for Gypsum)	Charges as specified in Section 3.1(B) of Chapter III of SOR.

The difference between the demurrage accrued after 61st day to 180th day (240th day for Gypsum) will be treated as remitted.

2. It should be noted that the trade will have to pay revised Storage fees as and when SOR is revised by Mumbai Port Authority.
3. The above scheme will remain valid for a period of **30 days** from 16.04.2024 to 15.05.2024. It shall be noted that the charges as specified in Section 3.1(B) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates are leviable for the period of storage beyond 15.05.2024 or from 181st day onwards for MOP and other cargo and 241st day onwards for Gypsum, whichever is earlier.
4. These being bulk cargoes, the precautions for pollution control measures will have to be taken by consignees/their handling Agents, as would be intimated from time to time, during handling, transport, storage, etc.
5. You are requested to inform your members accordingly
