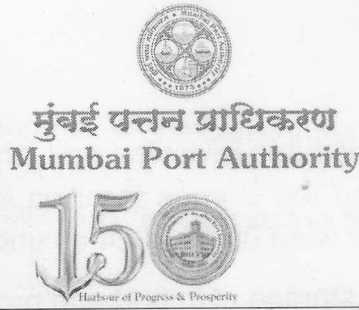

Sub: Extension of Storage facilities for import agricultural products and concessional storage upto 120 days, at Outlying Areas.

Ref : This office Circular No. TM/D/4-3/15 dated 14.08.2023.

Vide this office circular dated 14.08.2023, referred above, the facility of storage of import agricultural products upto 180 days in Outlying Areas was extended for a period of one year from 01.08.2023 till 31.07.2024

2. The scheme has been reviewed and it has been decided by the Competent Authority to extend the storage facilities for import agricultural products for a period of one year w.e.f 01.08.2024 as under:-


- (i) Long-term storage of import agri products in outlying notified areas upto a maximum of 120 days for cargo which is made out of charge by customs or which is permitted by customs to be shifted to customs nominated areas under Section 49 of Customs Act, 1962.
- (ii) The recovery of charges for storage of cargo maximum upto 120 days at outlying areas as per SOR shall be as under:-

- (iii) In the event of non-clearance of the consignments within a period of 120 days, demurrage shall be recovered at the rates specified in Section 3.1 (B) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates subject to revision/modification from time to time.
3. It is requested to note that in case of revision of Scale of Rates (SOR), revised charges as approved by the MbPA, will be applicable from the date of revision of SOR, from time to time.
4. The above scheme will remain valid for a period of one year i.e. upto 31.07.2025 and shall be reviewed thereafter.
5. Further, it is to inform that the fresh/extension storage applications received under the scheme informed vide Circular No. TM/D/4-3/15 dated 14.08.2023 will continue to be processed under the same scheme.
6. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail the facilities and bring more cargo to the Port.
