**LEVY OF CHARGES ON CONTAINERISED CARGO BROUGHT FROM INDIAN PORTS

Sub: Levy of charges on containerised cargo brought  
from Indian Ports by road to Mumbai Port.

In continuation to this office circular No. C/3-93/TM/Circular/13 of 1988-89 dated 28.06.2007, the free days/charges to be levied on the container and containerised cargo brought from other Indian Ports to Mumbai Port by road is extended for a further period of one year with effect from 01.07.2008. The free days/ charges will be as under:

I) **Containers Destuffed in the Port:**

(i) Container:

Three free days from the date of receipt of the container; licence (storage ) fee from the fourth day.

(ii) Containerised Cargo:

Five free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the sixth day.

II) **Containers Not Destuffed in the Port and Removed Out of the Port:**

(i) Container:

No free day and license (storage) fees will be levied from the day of receipt of container.

(ii) Containerised Cargo:

Three free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the fourth day.

The above free days/levy of charges on container and containerised cargo shall be applicable for a period of one year from 01.07.2008, and will be reviewed after 6 months.
