**Sub: Storage facilities for import bagged cargoes of Yellow Peas and Raw Sugar.**

Ref: This office circular No.TM/D/4-3/16  
of 1996-97 dated 17.7.2009.

*Vide* above referred circular, the long term storage facility for import bagged cargoes like pulses, etc. for a maximum period of 180 days at the specified areas was permitted upto 31.7.2010, subject to availability of storage areas, on receipt of application from Custom House Agents/Importers.

2. It has now been decided to continue the above facility for a further period of one year effective from 01.8.2010 for long term storage of Import bagged cargo of Yellow Peas and Raw Sugar in notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days, on recovery of charges as detailed below:

**(a) License (Storage) Fees on Import consignments of Raw-Sugar & Yellow Peas in the specified areas of Port:**

The Licence (Storage) Fees on storage of Raw-sugar and Yellow Peas will be recovered at following rates:

Location	Period of storage	Rate per sq.mtr. or part thereof, per month or part thereof. ( In Rs. )
Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	40.00
	31 <sup>st</sup> day to 180 <sup>th</sup> day	80.00
Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	30.00
	31 <sup>st</sup> day to 180 <sup>th</sup> day	60.00

**Note: In the event of non-clearance of cargoes within the period of 180 days, demurrage shall be recovered from 181<sup>st</sup> day onwards under Section 3.1B of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.**

3. The above scheme will be valid till 31.7.2011.

4. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail of the facility.
