Sub: Pre-shipment facility for storage

of export cargo.

Kind attention is invited to this office circulars No.TM/A/15-22/08, 10, 15 & 20 dated 05.6.2008, 04.7.2008, 28.7.2008 & 29.10.2007 respectively, vide which certain storage areas were nominated inside the Indira Dock as pre-shipment storage facilities for aggregation and storage of export cargoes.

2. In view of the demolition of transit sheds in P&V Docks as a part of the Offshore Container Terminal project, the pre-shipment storage area hitherto allowed in P&V Docks are required to be re-located. Accordingly, areas in Indira Dock will now be available for such pre-shipment storage facility.

3. In partial amendment of all above previous circulars related to Indira Dock, following areas are ear-marked for storage of pre-shipment facility of export cargo:

1.	13-B, ID Shed and BPX North Hall.	All iron & steel requiring covered area.	21 days	13B,ID - <u>8361 sq.m.</u> BPX N.Hall 2975 sq.m.
2.	Gamadia Complex (An area admeasuring approx. 12,000 sq. Mtr.)	All iron & steel requiring open storage area.	21 days.	12,000 sq.m.
3.	1-ID open area.	Over-Dimensional packages comprising project cargo and individual package weight exceeding 75 tonne.	21 days.	10,000 sq.m.
4.	13-A,ID Shed, 13-ID Open area & 5-ID Shed.	Sugar & oilcake.	21 days.	13-A Shed - <u>9290 sq.m.</u> 13-ID Open area <u>2445 sq.m.</u> 5-ID Shed 5000 sq.m.
5.	12A-ID Shed.	Oil cake.	21 days.	7665 sq.m.

4. It may be noted that whenever project consignments are carted at STP/Wadala Incinerator Yard under the pre-shipment storage facility conveyed vide this office circular No.TM/D/4-3/11 dated 11.7.2008, the same shall not be permitted to be shifted to 1-ID for pre-shipment storage.

5. Pre-shipment storage facilities pertaining to outlying areas and P&V Docks, conveyed through various earlier circulars, shall continue.

6. The cargo, if not shipped within 30 days of carting, then only 7 free days shall be allowed from the date of carting as against the 21 days mentioned in para No.3 above.

7. The above arrangement will come into force with immediate effect in respect of the requests made for such pre-shipment storage hereafter.

8. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail the facility.
