Sub: Extension of Storage facilities for import agricultural products and concessional storage upto 180 days, inside Docks at 12A ID, 12B ID, Temporary Shed at 12B ID and at Outlying Areas.

Ref: This office Circulars No.

- (i) TM/D/4-3/15 dated 30.08.2019.
- (ii) TM/A/15-33/28 dated 30.11.2019.
- (iii) TM/A/15-33/31 dated 13.12.2019.
- (iv) TM/A/15-33/36 dated 09.01.2020.

Vide this office circular dated 30.08.2019 referred at (i) above, the facility of storage of import agri products in the notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days was extended for a period of one year from 01.08.2019.

- 2. Vide this office circular dated 30.11.2019 referred at (ii) above, 12B ID temporary shed was notified for storage of import pulses for a maximum period of 60 days from Vessel Completion Date (VCD).
- 3. Vide this office circular dated 13.12.2019 referred at (iii) above, 12A ID and 12B ID sheds were notified for storage of import pulses for a maximum period of 60 days from Vessel Completion Date (VCD).
- 4. Vide this office circular dated 09.01.2020 referred at (iv) above, shifting of import Agri-products was allowed from Docks to the Custom notified areas for warehousing on long term basis (i.e. upto 180 days) for cargo which is made out of charge by Customs or which is permitted by Customs to be shifted to custom nominated areas under Section 49 of Custom Act, 1962.
- 5. The Board of Trustees has accorded approval for the extension of the following facilities:
- (i) As conveyed vide circular No. TM/D/4-3/15 dated 30.08.2019, the facility of long term storage of import agri- products in the outlying notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days for cargo which is made out of charge by Customs has been extended till 31.07.2021.
- (ii) As intimated by circular No. TM/A/15-33/28 dated 30.11.2019, storage of import agri-products at 12B ID Temporary Shed upto a maximum period of 60 days from Vessel Completion Date is extended till 31.07.2021, in terms of provision of Section 3.3(A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.
- (iii) As informed by circular No. TM/A/15-33/31 dated 13.12.2019, long term storage of import agri-products at 12A ID and 12B ID sheds upto a maximum period of 60 days from Vessel Completion Date is extended till 31.07.2021 in terms of provision of Section 3.3(A)(II) of Chapter III of Scale of Rates.

The recovery of charges for Dry Bulk Cargo at 12B ID Temporary Shed and at 12A ID and 12B ID sheds shall be as under: —

(iv) As per circular No. TM/A/15-33/36 dated 09.01.2020, long term storage of import Agri products in the outlying notified areas upto a maximum period of 180 days for cargo which is made out of charge by Customs or which is permitted by Customs to be shifted to custom nominated areas under Section 49 of Custom Act, 1962 will be as follows:

The recovery of charges for Dry Bulk Cargo for storage of cargo maximum upto 180 days at outlying areas, vide circulars No. TM/D/4-3/15 dated 30.08.2019 and No. TM/A/15-33/36 dated 09.01.2020 shall be as under:

(v) The storage of import agri products for a period of 180 days shall be inclusive of storage period of 60 days inside nominated areas in Docks i.e. 12A, 12B ID Sheds and 12B ID Temporary Shed.

In the event of non-clearance of the consignments within the period of 180 days, demurrage shall be recovered from 181st day onwards at the rates specified in Section 3.1 (B) of Chapter III of the Scale of Rates, subject to revision / modification from time to time.

- 6. For storage areas covered under GBL, the storage period will be limited to 180 days as approved by TR No.168 dated 17.03.2012 and the rates leviable will be Rs. 1.50 per sq. mtr. per day for first 15 days and Rs. 2.00 per sq. mtr. per day for 16th day to 180th day; whereafter charges @ Rs. 20 per sq. mtr. per day will be leviable from 181st day onwards as conveyed to the Trade by Circular No. TM/D/4-3/01 of 2012-13 dated 10.04.2012.
- 7. It is requested to note that in case of revision of Scale of Rates (SOR), revised charges as approved by the TAMP will be applicable from the date of revision of SOR, from time to time.
- 8. The above scheme will remain valid for a period upto 31.07.2021 and shall be reviewed thereafter.
- 9. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members to avail the facilities and bring more cargo to the Port.
