Minutes of the Dry Dock Allotment Planning Meeting held on 15/05/2009

The Open Public Dry Dock Allotment Planning meeting was held at 3.00 p.m. on 15/05/2009. Representatives of 46 user firms were present at the meeting.

2. Addl.Chief Mechanical Engineer (ACME) welcomed all the allottees and informed that

a) FA & CAO had forwarded particulars of outstanding bills uptill April towards Dry Dock services rendered to various parties and these names which have appeared and were present were requested to clear their respective outstanding dues and produce "No Dues Certificate" from FA & CAO's office for consideration of their vessels to firm up the actual allotments. In this regard reminder letters as regards L&T's Sushilla-III and M/s. Sai Shipping's Global Prosperity's pending payments have been issued to all concerned to ensure prompt recovery. L&T and Sai Shipping's representatives were accordingly requested to cooperate in the matter pending which their vessels are liable for detention.

b) ACME further advised all prospective applicants as under :

1. In case of cancellation to ensure that MbPT is intimated atleast 2 days (excluding the day of docking) prior to the date of actual docking as per the Dry Dock Bye-Laws or action as deemed fit will be taken by MbPT.
2. To arrange for and ensure payment of the advance at the FA&CAO's OSC Office as advised by the Sr.Exe.Engineer (W), HDD's office immediately upon receipt of allotment letter and produce copies of the payment receipt to this office and the Sr.Exe.Engineer (W),HDD. If this is not complied with, action as deemed fit will be taken by MbPT.
3. To ensure that Allottees stick to their period of actual allotment and not to extend the same creating hardships for those awaiting their turn.

c) In the last meeting it was informed that MbPT's OCT project work will commence from March 2009. MbPT has since awarded the contract for dredging and filling up of the P&V Dock basin. The dredgers undertaking the dredging work for the OCT project and for filling up the P&V Dock basin will be arriving shortly for this purpose. Accordingly, MDD applicants are once again being requested to keep shaped blocks ready if they desire dry docking in HDD. In this regard, TM's office has already issued vacation notices to vessels still berthed/moored in P&V Docks.

d) Emergency allotments will be dealt with as and when such applications are received. All allottees are directed to ensure that applications received must

be accompanied with copies of all the required certificates.

3) Further, as the present list was proving to be long and upon observation, it was noticed that some applicants were putting in applications much in advance in anticipation of expecting the repair work order from the Owners/Operators. Prospective allottees were also informed that with all issues/parameters considered more or less equal, claiming priority allotment on the basis of early entry into MbPT/Docks, holding wet berth in advance, etc. and using the same for circumventing MbPT's procedures/decision should preferably be avoided especially when existing allottees have already committed themselves. Nevertheless, MbPT has every right to take advance actions so as to avoid keeping the Dry Docks vacant if such eventualities arise. It is then upto the prospective allottees to take a considered decision covering all the possible risks.

4) A copy of the statement showing the status of the pending applications for allotment of dry docks was handed over to all the firms' representatives who were present at the meeting. The likely date and month of readiness of the vessels in the waiting list were then ascertained from them.

5) A tentative dry docking program for both Dry Docks was drawn up for the months of May, June & July 2009 covering the monsoon months based on each vessels readiness, dry dock availability, vessel dimensions, positioning availability of keel blocks, matching repair time, emergencies, etc.
