### **CIRCULAR**

In pursuant to circular received from the Directorate General of Shipping No.44-NT(08)/2007 dated 31<sup>st</sup> December 2009 all ships plying under the flag of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) which intend to visit the Port of Mumbai require the Master of the Vessel to give an undertaking that the vessel is not carrying / nor intends to carry any substance which have been banned by the UN Security Council Resolution 1874 of 2009.

2. This declaration is required to be submitted by the ship's agent to the Office of the Harbour Master of Mumbai Port during office working hours at least 72 hours before the arrival of such vessel. The Harbour Master's written permission is required for the vessel to be allowed into the Port of Mumbai.

3. If, for any reason it is suspected that the vessel is carrying any substance which is in contravention of the above mentioned UN Security Council Resolution, the Navy, Coast Guard and Customs will be requested to inspect and examine such vessel if carrying of such substance / substances is suspect.

4. This circular will be in force with immediate effect.

5. All the above are requested to take serious note and comply.
