**Sub: Amnesty Scheme for settlement of Sale
Deficits, Pre-Confiscation charges and
Destruction charges, etc.**

The Board of Trustees' of the Port of Mumbai have accorded sanction to reintroduce Amnesty Scheme to compromise all the pending suits and decrees pertaining to Sale Deficits, Pre-confiscation charges, Destruction charges etc.

- i) Suits/Decrees involving basic claim up to Rs.2 lakh will be compromised on payment of 30% of the claim amount, excluding interest;
- ii) Suits/Decrees involving basic claim exceeding Rs.2 lakh will be compromised on payment of Rs.60,000 + 50% of the claim amount above Rs.2 lakh, excluding interest;
- iii) To avail of the benefit of the scheme, you are requested to inform your members to make the payment by way of Pay Order / Demand Draft in favour of Board of Trustees of the Port of Mumbai as per the scheme. On receipt of the payment, necessary instructions to Solicitors for withdrawal of the suit will be given.

iv) **The Amnesty Scheme shall remain open till 30th November 2010.**
