Work profile:

Candidate will be required to attend the work related to VTS Operator, Data Entry, Shipping Assistant and any other work as directed by the Dy. Conservator.

- 2. Number of posts may increase or decrease as per the requirement.
- 3. Age limit: Retired from service at a Major Port within the last three years.
- 4. Experienced in Vessel Traffic Service operations in a Major Port Authority.
- 5. Remuneration, benefits and terms and conditions for appointment:
- (i) Duration of contract: The contract shall be initially for a period upto <u>one year</u> from the date of engagement.
- (ii) Selected candidate shall be paid a consolidated remuneration upto ₹ 50,000/- or <u>last pay drawn</u> minus <u>Basic pension</u> (per month) as per government rule, whichever is less. . No other allowances or benefits would be admissible.
- (iii) Duty Hours: Working pattern will be 12 hours on/12 hours off with weekly off as per work requirement. If situation warrants, the weekly day of rest may be changed with prior intimation.
- (iv) Leave entitlement Casual leave of 12 days and Earned Leave 20 days in a year are admissible, which shall be availed with prior approval. For any absence in excess, prorata deduction will be made from the consolidated remuneration. Casual Leave will be adjusted proportionately in case of shorter period of engagement.
- (v) Accommodation- If desired, Mumbai Port Authority accommodation as admissible will be provided, as per availability and on recovery of <u>rent at 25 times</u> the prescribed license fee for the unit allotted along with the electricity charges and water charges on consumption basis.

- (vii) Medical facility- No medical facility would be available to the employee and his family.
- (viii) The contract can be terminated by giving one month notice in writing from either side. If the candidate leaves without notice or acceptance of notice of termination, the amount due to him, consolidated remuneration payable to the extent of notice period will be forfeited. However, the engagement is terminable on 24-hour notice, for unsatisfactory performance and for any act that is considered detrimental to the interest of the Port.
- (ix) On completion of contract and if there is no further renewal then accommodation allotted to the candidate is to be vacated within one month.
- (x) The candidate shall be responsible for the charge and care of the Mumbai Port Authority goods, stores and other properties that may be entrusted to him/her and will be accountable for the same.
- (xi) The candidate will not have any claim/right whatsoever for regular appointment/absorption in Mumbai Port Authority under any circumstances.

6. General:

- (ii) Applicants may attach self certified copies of certificates/documents in support of their service in Major Ports with their application.
