Dear Sirs,

Sub: Levy of charges on containerized cargo brought from Indian Ports by <u>road</u> to Mumbai Port.

In continuation of this office circular No.TM/C/3-93/Circular/15 of 88-89 dated 10.06.2009, the facility of free days/charges on the container and containerised cargo brought from other Indian Ports to Mumbai Port by <u>road</u> is extended for a further period of one year from 01.07.2010 to 30.06.2011. The free days/charges will be as under:

(I) Containers Destuffed in the Port:

- (i) Container:
 - 3 Free days from the date of receipt of the container; licence (storage) fees from the fourth day.
- (ii) Containerised Cargo:

5 Free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the sixth day.

(II) Containers Not Destuffed in the Port and Removed Out of the Port:

- (i) <u>Container</u>:
 - No Free days. License (storage) fees will be levied from the day of receipt of container.
- (ii) Containerised Cargo:
 - 3 Free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the fourth day.
