Sub: Cyclone Tauktae – Storm Warning.

Refer to our circular No.DC/C-SH/2226 dated 14.5.2021 on the above subject. Further to mention here that cyclonic storm is likely to experience heavy weather and sustained Wind speeds upto 60 knots. To mitigate the impact of the cyclone on the ships in Mumbai Port waters and the Ports property, the following remedial steps are being taken –

1. It is planned to sail out all vessels at berth by 2300 hrs. on 15.5.2021 so as to give enough time to the vessels to cross the path of the cyclone and remain in navigable semi circle.
2. All shipping inward movements will remain suspended till ease of weather conditions.
3. All small crafts and crafts those are involved in construction activities of MTHL projects are advised to secure alongside. All ships anchored in Alpha anchorage during anchorage are advised to take all necessary steps for their safety which include high seas.
4. All barges are to secure their cargo handling gear and other related equipments and comply with the heavy weather contingency plan.
5. All small crafts, boats to take shelter in Inward/Bunder areas.
