Vide above referred circulars, 13A ID shed, 13 ID open area and 15 ID shed were nominated/specified for storage of raw sugar exports with the condition that carting for raw sugar shall be permitted 12 days prior to the ETA of the vessel.

It has been experienced that though carting has been permitted in the above sheds of Indira Dock for storage of raw sugar, the sugar consignments continue to lie in the sheds beyond the specific period thus blocking the valuable transit sheds inside Indira Dock.

In view of the above, 15 ID is denotified with effect from **12th May 2008** for storage of raw sugar under pre-shipment storage facility.
