Sub.: Weighbridge allocation

With the objective of ensuring "Ease of doing business" in Docks and bring efficiency and reduce costs to Trade, Mumbai Port Authority has already started three weighbridges at 13B ID, 7 ID & 7/8 VD inside docks.

To avoid vehicular congestion in docks and providing smooth services to Port users, allocation of the weighbridges will be as follows:

1	7 ID	BPX, BPS, 1ID, 2ID, 3ID, 4ID, 5ID, 6ID, 10ID, 11ID, 12ID, 12AID, 12BID, Railway siding at 6 ID.
2	7/8 VD	All Liquid Bulk Cargo handled at 14 VD, 23 ID and other berths of ID/ P&V.
3	13 B ID	13B ID, 13A ID, 14 ID, 15 ID, 16 ID, 17ID, 18 ID, 19 ID, 20 ID, 21 ID, 22 ID

- In case of vehicle congestion at one of the weighbridge, the traffic will be diverted to other convenient weighbridge.
- All Port Users are hereby requested to take note of the above for faster evacuation of cargo from Docks.
