Sub.: Remedial measures for removal of unsafe practices/ conditions during Cargo handling operations.

In one of the recent accidents one trailor driver was fatally injured when a pipe bundle fell on him while removing the lashing chains of export pipe bundles on the trailor. Standing in safe position while unlashing and observing safety precautions could have avoided the accident.

2. Inspite of issuance of various circulars in the past, it is observed that proper safety precautions are not being taken while handling of cargo.

- 3. In order to ensure proper measures for removal of unsafe practices / conditions during cargo handling it has been decided to implement the following measures with immediate effect.
 - Trucks / Trailors carrying export cargo including long / lengthy pipes, coils etc. shall not be allowed entry in the docks without proper lashing of cargo with wire ropes or iron chains and without properly fitted iron / steel side stanchions.
 - In case of delivery of import cargo, the delivery shall be allowed only of cargo
 which is properly secured with wire ropes / iron chain lashing and only on
 Trucks / Trailors having proper side stanchions.
 - Movement of cargo within the docks for storage purpose shall also be allowed only on Trucks / Trailors having proper side stanchions and cargo properly lashed with wire ropes / iron chain lashing.
 - Any transporter not following the above safety norms will be levied a penalty of Rupees One Lakh per incident.
 - At all cargo handling areas, use of Personal Protective Equipments like helmets, safety shoes, hand gloves, etc. shall be mandatory for all dock workers including contract labour and private labours engaged by Vessel Agents, CHB's, Transporters and Contractors.
 - To avoid cargo/men falling into sea/dock basin, securing of Pals, skid nets, etc. between vessel and wharf/below gangway be ensured.
 - A short Personal Protective Training of about 15 minutes shall be given to all contract & private labour and all drivers and cleaners at Shramik Bhavan.
 Dock Entry Permits shall be issued to them only after completion of the training.
- 4. The above measures are a mandatory requirement under Dock Workers (Safety, Health and Welfare) Act, 1986. Non compliance of the same shall be viewed seriously and action as deemed fit, including black listing of the defaulting firm / company shall be initiated.
