Vide above referred circular, the trade was informed that with effect from 01.3.2008, import bagged cargo shall be permitted long term storage in the notified areas upto maximum period of 120 days from the date of initial allotment on recovery of licence (storage) fees as detailed below:

	PERIOD OF STORAGE	RATE PER SQ.MTR. OR PART THERE-OF, PER MONTH OR PART THEREOF (in Rs.)
Sheds	First 30 days or part thereof	40.00
	31 <sup>st</sup> day to 120 <sup>th</sup> day	80.00

Open Yards	First 30 days or part thereof	30.00
	31 <sup>st</sup> day to 120 <sup>th</sup> day	60.00

2. In the event of non-clearance of the consignment within the period of 120 days, demurrage shall be recovered at the rates specified in section 3.1(B) of chapter III of revised Scale of Rates.
3. It has been decided to continue the facility of long term storage till **31.12.2008**.
