Sub : Compliance of Safety Norms inside Docks


Vide Circular Nos. 26 dated 15.11.2010 and TM/HD/2-2/975 of 2015-16 dated 16.09.2015, you were requested to inform your members to ensure that Cleaners are invariably deployed alongwith Drivers on the vehicles entering the Docks for transportation/handling of cargo to prevent any untoward incident and loss of human life. It is, however, observed that some of the vehicles engaged for cargo handling work enters Docks without Cleaners.

2. Further, use of PPEs like Helmets, Safety Shoes, Hand Gloves etc. is a mandatory requirement as per Dock Workers' Safety, Health and Welfare Act, 1986, however very often it has been observed that many personnel working inside the Docks Cargo Operational Area are not using the same. In this regard, vide Circular No. TM/Z/1-10/25 dated 01.01.2015 and 20.08.2015, it was requested that all personnel working in the Cargo Operational Area shall invariably wear the Helmets. Also, while driving the vehicles inside Docks Road Discipline is not adhered to.

3. You are requested to inform your members –

- (i) to ensure that Cleaners are invariably deployed alongwith the Drivers on the vehicle entering the Docks for transportation/handling of cargo, failing which vehicles will not be allowed to enter the Docks.
- (ii) All personnel working inside Dock Operational Areas shall invariably use the PPEs such as Helmets, Safety Shoes, Hand Gloves etc.
- (iii) Road Discipline inside Docks shall be strictly followed.

5. Any non-compliance to the above shall be viewed seriously and action as deem fit shall be taken against defaulters.
