**Sub: Levy of charges on containerised
cargo brought from Indian Ports
by road to Mumbai Port.**

In continuation to this office circular No.C/3-93/TM/Circular/07 of 88-89 dated 03.06.2008, the free days/charges to be levied on the container and containerised cargo brought from other Indian Ports to Mumbai Port by road is extended for a further period of one year with effect from 01.07.2009 to 30.06.2010. The free days/charges will be as under:

(I) **Containers Destuffed in the Port:**

(i) Container:

3 Free days from the date of receipt of the container; licence (storage) fees from the fourth day.

(ii) Containerised Cargo:

5 Free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the sixth day.

(II) **Containers Not Destuffed in the Port and Removed Out of the Port:**

(i) Container:

No Free day and licence (storage) fees will be levied from the day of receipt of container.

(ii) Containerised Cargo:

3 Free days from the date of receipt of container and demurrage from the fourth day.
