**Sub: Implementation of Transparency Plan –
Receipts and Payments by electronic / digital
modes of payment.**

MbPT's various cash transactions are being done through electronic payment by way of RTGS/NEFT or ECS. However, various receipts /transactions are still being effected in cash.

2. In view of Ministry's directions, it has been decided to limit cash transactions to Rs.200/- for any kind of payment by port users with effect from 15.01.2017.

3. It is, therefore, requested that payment towards any Port Trust charges should be made by way of Demand Draft or electronic / digital modes of payment and MbPT will not accept payment towards Port Trust charges above Rs.200/- in cash with effect from 15.01.2017.

4. In this regard, MbPT is making arrangement for installation of Point of Sales (POS) machines at various cash collection points.

5. You are requested to give wide publicity amongst your members. You are also requested to co-operate in this regard to make the effort of cashless transaction a grand success.
