**IMPLEMENTATION OF CHARGE FOR USE OF MbPA  
PRIVATE ROADS**

Link Road portion between Malet Road Junction & Victoria Overbridge(Reay Road) and Wadala – Mahul Road which are MbPA roads are open to public vehicles on payment of charge. The details of the charges levied on vehicles using above MbPA Roads are as under:

**1. The charges for use of MbPA's roads being collected at MbPA's Road Charge Collection Centres are as follows:**

LMV (4 wheelers, 3 wheelers)	-	Rs.30	for using link road as well as WMR.
HMV (Trucks/Buses etc.)	-	Rs.50	for using link road as well as WMR.
HMV (Trailers)	-	Rs.70	for using link road only*.

\* except on emergencies HMV (Trailers) are not allowed on WMR.

Note: The above charges once levied at one Charge Collection Center shall be valid for both the Charge Collection Center for one-way trip for the day.

**2. The following categories of vehicles are exempted from paying charges for use of MbPA roads through Road Charge Collection Centre:**

- MbPT vehicles (vehicles in which MbPT employee is travelling will also be allowed to pass without any charge).
- Ambulances.
- Fire Fighting Vehicles.
- Police Vehicles.
- Government vehicles having Red and Amber beacons.
- Defense LMVs and Defense two wheelers.

- (g) Hearses.
- (h) Prime movers of container trailer/ chassis with or without container (to be permitted only on Link Road), going to or coming from the Docks/ CFS/ RCD with RFID tags.

(i) Complimentary permits issued by MbPT to following companies

- (j) Customs staff on valid Identity Card issued by Customs Department.
- (k) Coast Guard's vehicles.
- (l) Home Guard's vehicles.
- (m) Staff of Narcotic Control Bureau having valid identity card issued by the Bureau.
- (n) Complimentary Passes issued by Chairman and Dy.Chairman of MbPT – 50 Passes per Year.
- (o) Motor vehicles (Automobiles) for export either in closed car carriers or individually driven.
- (p) Lorries passing through Road Charge Collection Centre at Reay Road for using the Weigh Bridge located at MOD, Reay Road for disposal work.
