Conditions

The permission to the consignee to store export cargo at Grain Depot _____ shed is given subject to following conditions:

- 1.** The consignee is permitted to store the cargo under the T. R. No.180 of 2001 under which he is permitted to store the cargo under free shipping facility scheme for export through MB.P.T. for 30 days. However, the charge for storage beyond 30 days and for such cargo which is not exported through MB.P.T. the charges are to be levied as provided in aforesaid T. R. 180 of 2001.
- 2.** The permission granted to consignee is at his sole risk for any loss or damage during its storage in Grain Depot.
- 3.** At the time of taking delivery the consignee shall furnish the particulars of Lorry No. Container No. and the place to which the goods shifted on the delivery format given by Goods Clerk. Consignee shall also give the details of the export document like Shipping Bill & Carting Order to SM/GC.
- 4.** The consignee shall pay all the charges pertaining to the storage transactions before taking the delivery.
- 5.** SM/GC is to ensure that party is not in arrears of any charges pertains to earlier transaction and must collect the details about the shipping bill and carting order and also duly filled the delivery format from the consignee. Consignee shall be charged for entire bay irrespective of area

occupied by cargo in a bay.
